The Easter Story – The Miracles

Read It: John 10:37-38

Think About It: Jesus was stirring up trouble again, by telling the truth and doing good works. He was at the feast of dedication in Jerusalem. It was winter, and those gathered around Him asked, “How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Christ, tell us plainly.” He did. He told them that He had already told them plainly, and they didn’t believe Him. Then He told them that the “works” He did in His Father’s name backed up His claim. He also told them that His followers would inherit eternal life, and that He and the Father were one.

That’s when they picked up stones. Jesus asked them, “For which of the good works are you stoning me?” They said it wasn’t for any of the good works, but for blaspheme. Jesus countered by saying that He had only claimed what was written in Psalm 82: “all of you are sons of the Most High.” The Psalmist had compared those who judged unjustly and showed partiality for the wicked to “all of you” who had vindicated the weak and fatherless; who had given justice to the afflicted and destitute. And who had rescued the weak and needy, delivering them out of the hand of the wicked. Jesus had done those sorts of things.

It is odd that they believed John the Baptist to be from God despite his call for repentance, and never once performing a single miracle. But rejected what John said about Jesus, even though it was true. And they also rejected what Jesus said about Himself even though He backed it up with miracles while doing what “sons of God” were supposed to do.

Jesus challenged them to consider what His “works” meant. If He wasn’t doing the “works of the father” they should not believe Him. But if He did them, they should believe. Some were convinced, but most would not allow themselves to accept what His words and works clearly revealed. We have to rely on the testimony of those who saw what He did. We have to determine whether they are trustworthy or not. Some will see that they are and others will reject them as fanciful.

But there is more to consider. Jesus is not done doing the “works of His Father.” He continues to do them through the lives of His followers; who are inspired by His Spirit to do the works that He did. Like John, we may never perform a miracle, but we can help the least of these, just as Jesus did. It reveals a lot about our claim to be children of our Heavenly Father. We leave the miracles in Jesus’ hands, God’s only begotten Son, but we pray for them to be done. And His greatest work, uniquely His, was done on the cross. His resurrection confirmed His claim/
